**European Parliament resolution on climate and environment urgency
(2019/xxxx(RSP))**

The European Parliament,

- having regard to the Intergovernmental Panel on Climate Change (IPCC) special report entitled ‘Global Warming of 1.5°C’, its fifth assessment report (AR5) and its synthesis report, the IPCC special report on Climate Change and Land, and the IPCC special report on the Ocean and Cryosphere in a Changing Climate,
 - having regard to the massive threat of loss of biodiversity described by the Global Assessment Report on Biodiversity and Ecosystem Services by the Intergovernmental Science-Policy Platform on Biodiversity and Ecosystem Services in its report of 6 May of 2019,,
 - having regard to the decision by the President of the United States on the 4th of November 2019 to withdraw from the Paris Agreement,
 - having regard to the 25st Conference of Parties of the United Nations Framework Convention on Climate Change to be held in a Madrid, Spain, from 2nd to 13th of December 2019,
 - having regard to Rules 136(5) and 132(2) of its Rules of Procedure,
1. Declares the climate and environment urgency and declares the necessity for sustainable, science-based climate action in Europe and globally and calls on the Commission and the Member States to take urgent action to combat climate change in a holistic manner involving all sectors of society and the economy, including industry, in a socially balanced and sustainable way in order not to endanger jobs or put an undue burden on those least able to afford it.
