**European Parliament resolution on climate and environmental emergency
(2019/2930(RSP))**

The European Parliament,

- having regard to the Intergovernmental Panel on Climate Change (IPCC) special report entitled ‘Global Warming of 1.5°C’, its fifth assessment report (AR5) and its synthesis report, the IPCC special report on Climate Change and Land, and the IPCC special report on the Ocean and Cryosphere in a Changing Climate,
 - having regard to the massive threat of loss of biodiversity described by the Global Assessment Report on Biodiversity and Ecosystem Services by the Intergovernmental Science-Policy Platform on Biodiversity and Ecosystem Services in its report of 6 May of 2019,
 - having regard to the decision by the President of the United States on the 4th of November 2019 to withdraw from the Paris Agreement,
 - having regard to the 25th Conference of Parties of the United Nations Framework Convention on Climate Change to be held in a Madrid, Spain, from 2nd to 13th of December 2019,
 - having regard to the statement by the Commission of 25 November 2019 on climate and environmental emergency,
 - having regard to Rule 132(2) of its Rules of Procedure,
1. Declares an environmental and climate emergency in Europe and globally, and calls on the Commission and the Member States, and commits itself, to take action accordingly;
 2. Instructs its President to forward this resolution to the Council, the Commission, the governments and parliaments of the Member States.
